It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of Herbert "Kipps" Magalhães, 92, on January 28, 2024.

Kipps was born December 8, 1931 in Princes Town, Trinidad, to the late Joaquim and Mildred (née Baptiste) Magalhães. He emigrated to Canada in 1956 and joined the Royal Canadian Air Force.
