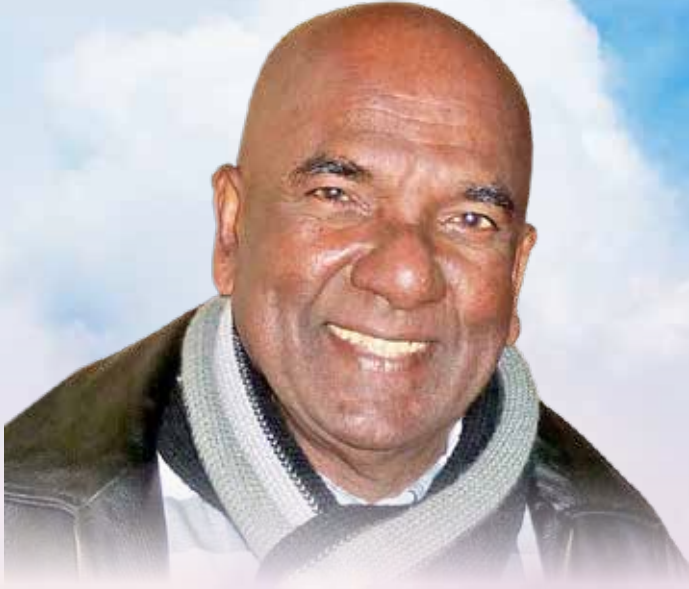


Pooran Ramlakhan:
